

## ABOUT GRADO EAR PADS...

---



- These tiny ear pads are called “**EXTRA SMALL PADS**” and used on “**i GRADO**” only.



- These pads, called “**SMALL PADS**” were used up to 2009 on SR60; they are now fitted on SR60i/e SR80i/e and SR125i/e. They are made of very soft foam. The thin layer of foam is not really affecting the sonic result.



- These “donut style” pads are called “**LARGE PADS**” They were up to 2009, used on SR80, 125, 225, 325, RS2 and RS1; they are now fitted on SR225i/e, SR325i/e, RS2i/e, RS1i/e and PS500/e. They have a more “audiophile approach”, no material between the driver and the ears. Headphones fitted with the 3 above pads are called “supra-aural”: they sit on the ears.

For comfort reasons, end user could decide to use our “**SMALL PADS**” on model using “**LARGE PADS**”; they would fit without any problem and wouldn't noticeably alter the sonic result.



- These ear pads called “**EXTRA LARGE PADS**” can be found on GS1000i/e and PS1000/e. They are about 10cm in diameter. Headphones using these pads, are called “circum-aural” because they encapsulate the ears. Using these on other models is not recommended: the tonal balance would be affected.

Maintenance kits for intra-auricular models (iGi, GR8 and GR10) are available.
